


# CIRMA E-Learning Center

### Bloodborne Pathogens Online Training Course Description

Any employee who comes into contact with blood or other body fluids is at risk for acquiring a bloodborne pathogen such as HIV/AIDS, Hepatitis B Virus, and other infectious diseases.

This online course will help employees understand the dangers associated with bloodborne pathogens and the risk of potential exposure in the workplace. Employees will learn to identify ways to protect themselves and others from infection, in addition to learning safe clean-up and waste disposal requirements for potentially contaminated items.
