Please reference the attached slick sheets for Resilient Time for Critical Infrastructure. These Resilient Time slick sheets have recently been developed by a cross-sector working group consisting of the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA), other government partners, and industry representatives from the Information Technology and Defense Industrial Base Sectors. These sheets are designed to increase awareness of alternate timing systems and reduce vulnerabilities associated with the use of GPS.

Also included in the slick sheets is information regarding the upcoming Week Number Rollover. Every 19 years, GPS's week counter must reset to zero and the next reset will occur on April 6, 2019. Users of GPS are encouraged to contact the user manufacturer to ensure their systems are configured to manage the rollover.
