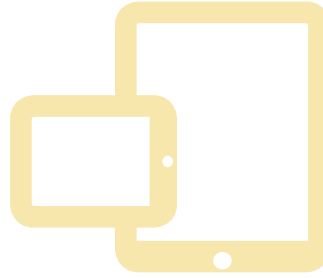


Bomb Threat Response Online Training Program
