Course Description

No one should ever be afraid to come to school for fear of being victimized by a bully. Nevertheless, bullying does occur. When it does, schools need to be prepared to treat each incident seriously and take steps to assure that victims are kept safe from further intimidation and those who bring bullying incidents to the attention of teachers and administrators are safe from retaliation. Finally, the bullies themselves must be disciplined so that further incidents can be avoided. All of this involves changing the mindset of all the stakeholders in this issue.

In this course, the learner will gain understanding regarding the importance of having a standardized process in place for reporting bullying incidents, the importance empathy plays in eliminating bullying from schools and finally, identifying the participants necessary to make an anti-bullying policy work.
