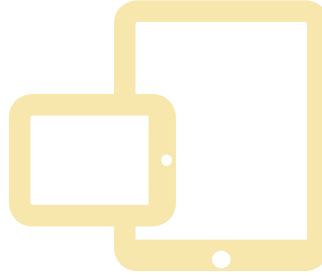


Law Enforcement Liability Online Training Program
