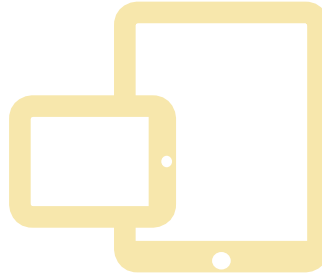

## Crowd Control Online Training Program

### Course Description:

Trying to second guess the mood of a crowd can be difficult. Good planning, however, can make the difference between an event taking place with minimal police involvement and an event that is marred by incidents between crowd members, or law enforcement and crowd members, ultimately involving multiple arrests. Even good planning, however, may not always be enough to prevent incidents from occurring.

In this course, the learner will gain insight regarding the importance of planning and training for use of force and arrest situations during crowd control incidents, as well as an understanding of the role the use of force continuum plays in crowd control, and the value of the Incident Control System in ensuring a successful operation.
