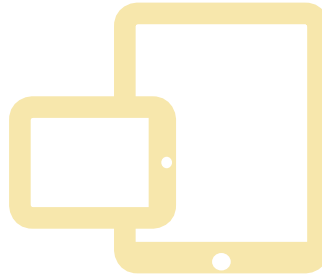

Hazards OSHA requires employers to provide their employees with detailed information and training on the chemicals they work with and to keep the information where it is easy to access. This is accomplished by means of the Safety Data Sheet (SDS).
