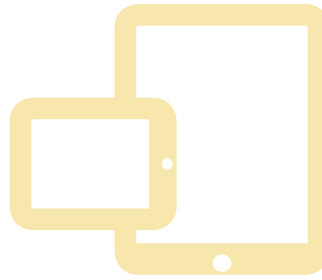

Regardless of the type of structure involved, you can use the basic firefighting principles of Rescue, Exposure, Containment, Extinguishment and Overhaul as your outline whenever you're on the scene of a structural fire.

A thorough understanding of how scene-specific factors such as building construction can influence the nature of a given fire can help you safely and effectively attack each fire. Obtain as much information as possible about each particular fire scene before you mount your attack. Observation and inquiry—coupled with knowledge and training—gives you the best chance for a successful outcome.
