MISSION STATEMENT

The Law Enforcement Advisory Committee was established by the Board of Directors. Membership is comprised of officials from CIRMA-member police departments as well as individuals from the private sector who have been appointed by the Board of Directors for a two-year term.

The Committee will have the following responsibilities:

- Provide a forum for exchange of ideas and to establish best practices for managing law enforcement risks.
- Develop guidelines for reducing law enforcement injury and liability exposures.
- Establish benchmarks for municipal police department and general government agency initiatives related to law enforcement.
- Review current law enforcement accident trends and discuss prevention and mitigation strategies.
