

Telling a lie to collect Workers' Compensation Benefits is not only wrong; **it's a crime.**



Workers' Compensation Fraud can take on many forms such as making false claims, withholding information, exaggerating claims, and working at another job while collecting benefits.

Workers' Compensation Fraud is a violation of Connecticut General Statute 31-290c (2019). If the benefits obtained through fraud exceed \$2,000, the offense is a Class B felony punishable by up to 20 years in prison and up to \$10,000 in fines.
